GENERAL GUIDELINES – APPLICATION FOR BBAC SCHOLARSHIP

- Applications must be made no later than four weeks prior to the start of a term; those received after that time will be retained and submitted for the next class period.
- Scholarship awards are based on financial need and, if applicable, merit, which the applicant is asked to detail in a "letter of intent" (see below).
- The scholarship must be used for the term issued. If the specified class is canceled for any reason, the scholarship will be valid for the immediate next term. (No cash equivalents or refunds apply at any time.)
- Scholarship funds may NOT pay for any model or materials fees. If that is the case, these costs are to be
 paid by the recipient. In any case, scholarship funds are not furnished to cover the cost of purchases from
 the instructor's material list.
- The scholarship is not retroactive. Fees will not be covered for a class in which the recipient is previously enrolled.
- Scholarships are not renewable and valid only for the specified term. A student may apply once a year for a BBAC scholarship.
- Scholarship recipients (or their parents) are asked to participate in the "Give Back" program, detailed on at the end.

THE APPLICATION

- The application form must be completed and submitted with requested "attachments." All attachments must accompany the original application.
- A letter of intent is required. Clearly state your reasons for applying for a BBAC scholarship funds. The BBAC is most interested in your "artistic passion"; financial considerations should be included. (Youth in grades 3-12 should write their own letter. For children in preschool and K-2, the "letter of intent" may be written by parents, teacher, or guardian.)
- One or two letters of reference are required OR provide contact information (see application) for references.
- Applicants grades Pre K-12 must submit images or samples of artwork (3-4). Originals will be returned.

THE PROCESS

- The BBAC's Scholarship Committee reviews all submissions and determines which scholarship fund is applicable.
- Applicants will be notified by email or phone as to whether or not a scholarship is awarded.
- Submit applications to Susan Owens (see below).
