Please be aware that students enrolled in jewelry/metalsmithing classes at the BBAC may be using a variety of metal working equipment including hand tools, power tools and torches to complete their project. Detailed instruction and safety information will be given prior to the use of any equipment. Students will be closely supervised by the instructor & trained counselors.

Closed toe shoes and long pants must be worn at all times in the metals studio. Students should also bring their own pair of safety goggles that can be purchased at most hardware stores. Optional: An old pair of snug fitting gloves (leather or gardening gloves). Harbor Freight is a good inexpensive source for goggles and gloves. Harbor Freight also carries goggles in size small.

This form must be completed before the student can work with the metalsmithing equipment.
