



Coronavirus & the BBAC

We share the concerns about the Coronavirus. The well-being of our students & visitors is always of great importance to the BBAC.

We will continue to monitor the situation carefully & follow recommendations from federal, state & local authorities.

MEANWHILE:

- Stay home if you are sick.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use at least a 60% alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your face.
- Cover nose or mouth with a tissue or flexed elbow when coughing or sneezing.
- If you've traveled to a country that has a Level 3 Travel Health
 Notice (widespread, ongoing transmission), including China, Italy,
 Iran and South Korea, do not come to the BBAC. You should stay
 home for at least 14 days from the time you left that country and practice
 social distancing.

As a reminder: class size @ the BBAC is usually 12 or less. Know that we have increased cleaning services with daily (or more frequent) disinfection of items often used plus handrails, doorknobs/pulls, the elevator, etc.
