



Coronavirus & the BBAC

We share the concerns about the Coronavirus. The well-being of our students & visitors is always of great importance to the BBAC.

We will continue to monitor the situation carefully & follow recommendations from federal, state & local authorities.

MEANWHILE:

- **Stay home if you are sick.**
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use at least a 60% alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your face.
- Cover nose or mouth with a tissue or flexed elbow when coughing or sneezing.
- **If you've traveled to a country that has a Level 3 Travel Health Notice (widespread, ongoing transmission), including China, Italy, Iran and South Korea, do not come to the BBAC.** You should stay home for at least 14 days from the time you left that country and practice social distancing.

As a reminder: class size @ the BBAC is usually 12 or less. Know that we have increased cleaning services with daily (or more frequent) disinfection of items often used plus handrails, doorknobs/pulls, the elevator, etc.
