MEDICATIONS

Authorization to Administer Medication Form: P/K-Grades 12

This is a required form for any camper taking medications during camp hours and must be received at least one week prior to the first day. Make arrangements to drop off medications before the first day (contact: camp@bbartcenter.org).

METALS STUDIO

Metals Studio: Equipment Permission Form: Grades 6-12

This is a required form for all students enrolled in the Jewelry/Metals Camps /Workshops and Middle School Art Camps.

LUNCH & SNACKS

FULL DAY campers should bring a non-refrigerated lunch, two snacks, beverages and water for the entire camp day. The water cooler will not be available due to COVID-19 protocol.

HALF DAY campers should bring a snack and water daily.
BBAC vending machines are off-limits for all summer campers.

CAMP ATTIRE

All campers are required to wear closed toe shoes and should dress for a mess. Art smocks are not provided.

For Middle School Art Camp & All Jewelry/Metals Camps

Students are required to wear long pants, closed toe shoes, their own safety goggles and snug fitting gloves. Garden gloves or old leather gloves work well.

COVID-19 CAMP PROTOCOLS

The BBAC follows recommended COVID-19 guidelines for safe practices. Stay informed for any camp updates - check your emails daily prior to and while your child is attending camp.

Face masks are required for anyone entering the BBAC building and campers must wear them throughout the duration of camp with the exception of snack & lunch breaks. Send your child with an extra face mask in their backpacks.

Weather permitting, campers will be outside on the BBAC grounds for lunch & snack breaks and some art-making.

Campers will socially distance between non-household individuals when possible.

Campers stay with their assigned group to limit the number of people they come into contact with each day.

Students and camp staff will wash and sanitize hands regularly throughout the day. If your child has a sensitivity to some hand sanitizers, you must provide one for them to keep at the BBAC.

The water cooler will no longer be available for use. Campers should bring enough water for the entire day.

Campers will be provided with their own set of sanitized art materials for camp use only.

Campers will have a temperature check when they arrive each day. Campers **must** stay home if, in the past 24 hours, they have experienced any of the following symptoms:

- Fever (104.4) or chills
- Cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing
- muscle or body aches
- vomiting or diarrhea
- new loss of taste or smell
